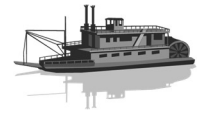

Directions

Just South of **70** at the Midway Exit 121 (3 miles East of N. Stadium Blvd. in Columbia).
Take **40** South of the exit (also the entrance ramp back onto **70** East) to **UU** on the right (South),
then turn left (East) on W. Van Horn Tavern Rd.

The building is on the Northeast corner of **UU** and W. Van Horn Tavern Rd.,

and is visible from the Interstate and will be on the left (North), and adjacent to the **Midway** campus.
