# Memorabilia Auction Bidder's Agreement

**Welcome!** We hope you enjoy participating, while helping to make the benefits of Scouting available to more youth. Listed below are the rules of the auction. Please take a moment to review them and register to be a bidder.

## Event Objectives

- Raise funds to support Scouting programs in the *Mountain West Council*
- Promote ethical Scouting memorabilia collecting and trading habits.
- Make some new friends and have a great time.

## General Information and Schedule

The auction includes: 9 silent auction rounds, 2 long-term auction rounds (held during the silent auction period), and 1 live auction. Silent auction rounds will last approximately 15 minutes.

The live auction will start after a short lunch break. Please honor the starting and ending times of each auction as announced.

## Auction Rules and Terms of Sale

1. The memorabilia auction is open to registered participants only. All bidders must register and read the bidder's agreement before participating in the auction.
2. All registration materials, bid numbers, and bid amounts must be written legibly.
3. Bidders will be identified by number rather than by name. The auctioneer will record all sales, for both silent and live auctions, under the registration number only.
4. All articles of merchandise are offered, "as is" and "where is" in units of measure announced at the time of the sale.
5. Bidding means an intention to buy. Please do not bid unless you are prepared to pay for the item. Bids cannot be canceled except by a higher bid or failure to follow the auction rules.
6. The auctioneer may refuse to accept or acknowledge any bid that is merely a fraction advance over the preceding bid. In the event of a tie bid, the auctioneer may re-open the bidding to determine the highest bidder. All sales are final upon the award of the bid.
7. We reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
8. Minimum bid is at the discretion of the auctioneer for the live auction and \$1.00 for silent auction, unless otherwise noted. Minimum raise for silent auction is \$0.50.
9. If, at the end of a silent auction round (including the long-term silent auction), two or more bidders are actively bidding on a particular lot, a brief live auction may be conducted for those who bid on the lot only, at the request of one of the bidders.
10. All purchases are to be paid in full at the auction. There will be ample opportunity to do this at the Cashier's location. Payment may be made in cash, approved check, or credit card. A written receipt will be issued. Make checks payable to: **Mountain West Council**, BSA or BSA.
11. All purchased items must be taken with you after the end of the auction.

## Trade-O-Ree Rules

### ***Welcome to the Mountain West Council Trade-O-Ree!***

It is hoped you will appreciate this time to trade and socialize, returning home with new associations and something special for your collection. To ensure fair trading practices and an enjoyable time for all, Trade-O-Ree participants are reminded to follow the Code of Ethics of International Scouting Collectors Association (ISCA):

**I** will:

**S**et an example in which all ISCA members will take pride,

**C**onsciously, fairly represent items of Scout memorabilia,

**A**lways follow the rules of the event that apply to trading,

**E**xtend the hand of friendship to all collectors,

**T**rade or sell no patch that I know to be a fake or reproduction w/o disclosing the fact,

**H**elp new collectors get started,

**I**mpress on new collectors the importance of ethics in trading,

**C**urrently be eligible to be registered in Scouting,

**S**trive for fairness in all actions consistent with the Scout Oath & Law.

The following additional suggestions may help make the **Mountain West Council** | Trade-O-Ree more pleasant for all:

- Adults should be conscious of their influence on young traders. Make sure the young trader feels good about the trade.
- Always use fair market evaluation of memorabilia values. Get a second opinion on higher value items.
- It is poor trading etiquette to cut in or interrupt during a trade with a comment that may influence the trade process.
- Watch out for fake patches. It is unfortunate that many fakes, reproductions and counterfeits surface quite frequently.
- Keep a close eye on your valuable items. Always remember, "A Scout is Trustworthy".
- Conclude each trade with a Scout handshake. The lasting friendship is more valuable than the patch.
